REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME DEPARTMENT AND THE
SCOTTISH MINISTERS ON THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR PROMOTION TO THE
RANK OF LEADING FIREFIGHTER
PART I - WRITTEN EXAMINATION 2000

1. The examination was set on the syllabus of study published in December 1999. This was the Fifteenth occasion on which the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Leading Firefighter was conducted by the Board.
2. Assessors responsible for the setting of question papers, the preparation of notes for the guidance of examiners and for the co-ordination of marking were appointed as follows:

3. Examination centres at 60 locations were arranged by the local examination boards.
4. The examination was held on 26 September 2000.
5. 1903 candidates initially entered for the examination as at the Board's closing date for entries (1 July). However, the final number of candidates entering the examination was 1815, after late entries and withdrawals had both been accepted. 331 (18.2%) absented themselves from the examination. Thus, the number of candidates who attended the examination was 1484.
6. A total of 40 officers attended the marking session together with three assessors, the General Assessor (Scotland) and the Chairman of the Panel of Assessors.
7. The marking of scripts took place at Daventry from 29 October to 3 November 2000.

RESULTS

8. Of the 1484 candidates who attempted the whole examination, 304 (20.5%) of those who sat were awarded a pass. *Appendix B (Table II) shows the cumulative results for all candidates entered.*
9. The 1484 candidates attempting the examination included 62 females, of whom 13 were successful in passing the whole examination.
10. The top candidate, Firefighter Daniel Edward Barton, attained 91% in Paper 1, 94% in Paper 2, 78% in Paper 3 and 70% in Paper 4. The candidate attained an 81% mark overall.
11. 331 candidates were absent for all papers of the examination. In addition, 36 candidates were absent from individual papers and under the Restriction of Entry Scheme, 27 candidates (7.4%) appealed to the Board against their automatic barring from next year's examination. Under the delegated authority given to the Chairman all appeals were individually considered and 26 (96.3%) were upheld.

GENERAL COMMENTS

12. This was the first application of the new examination format using four Papers with all questions to be answered rather than the previous two Papers with a choice of questions, and the provision of one sitting for the examination instead of the two previously used.
13. The number of candidates who entered the 2000 examination was 1815, a decrease of 9.4%, and the number of candidates absenting themselves was 331 (18.2%) which in both numerical and percentage terms is a large increase. This left 1484 candidates actually attempting the examination, a decrease of 289 (16.3%) when compared with last year.
14. Of the 1484 candidates who sat the examination, 304 (20.5%) were awarded a pass, which is a decrease on the pass rate of 853 (42.6%) in 1999.
15. As a result of the flexible system for taking the examination, 995 are indicated as having obtained a pass in at least one of four papers of the examination and are able to progress towards achieving a full pass during the next two years.

16. It is apparent that numerous candidates made significant effort to prepare themselves for the examination which was evidenced by the quality of their answers to the set questions and with excellent scripts being produced. Unfortunately, these were in the minority and it remains evident that many had not adequately prepared. 226 passed none of the papers attempted, although this is a reduction in numerical and percentage terms when compared to the previous year.
17. It is difficult to compare the passes recorded for the individual papers of the examination due to the changes that have been applied. However, Paper 1 provided a pass rate of 55.6% which is a reduction on the pass rate of 62.7% for the similar Paper 1 of last year. This weaker responses were recorded for the questions related to the characteristics of a centrifugal pump and safe systems of work.
18. There was evidence of a general improvement in the level of knowledge displayed on many aspects covered by the questions in Paper 2 but the overall pass rate of 38.9%, which is a sad reflection of the 50.2% pass rate achieved in this similar Paper last year, was almost entirely due to a general lack of knowledge being displayed of the Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997.
19. Paper 3 – Human Resource Management, was new to the examination and the Paper's pass rate of 32.7% is disappointing. The overall level of knowledge displayed by candidates in their answers is indicated by this pass rate. There was a weakness in all aspects of the subject matter which were examined.
20. Paper 4 – Business Administration, related to similar subject matter previously examined at Sub-Officer level. The quality of responses provided by candidates was good with some excellent scripts being presented. A pass rate for this paper of 70.9% reflects the general standard of scripts submitted.
21. There were no problems with the format of the examination or the instructions to candidates contained in the individual papers.

ASSESSORS AND EXAMINERS' REPORT

22. Detailed comments of the assessors and examiners in connection with the answering of individual questions have been prepared and will be issued to brigades.

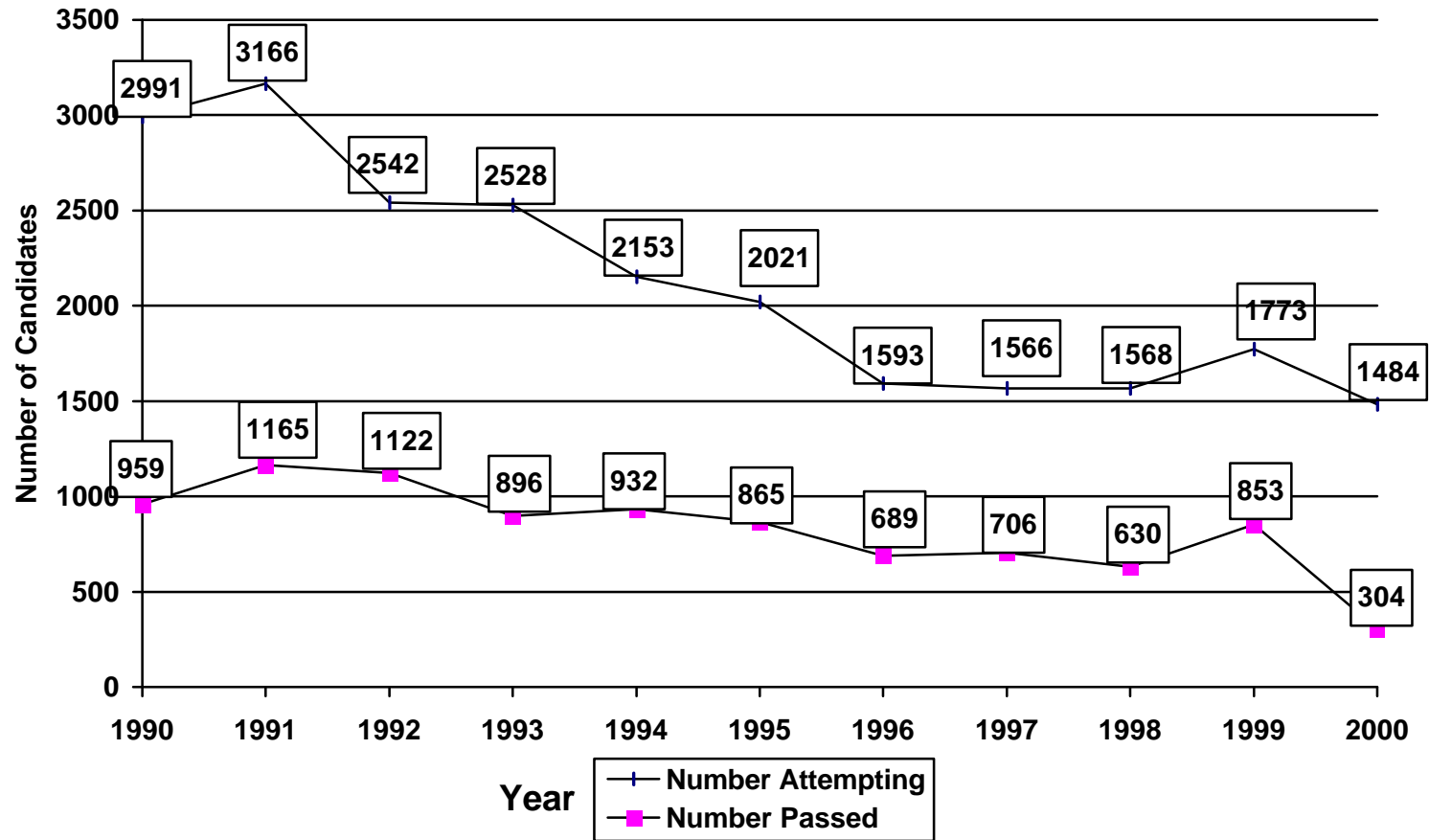
SUMMARY OF RESULTS
