REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND
THE REGIONS, AND THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS ON THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION
FOR PROMOTION TO THE RANK OF LEADING FIREFIGHTER
PART I - WRITTEN EXAMINATION 2001

1. The examination was set on the syllabus of study published in December 2000. This was the Sixteenth occasion on which the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Leading Firefighter was conducted by the Board.
2. Assessors responsible for the setting of question papers, the preparation of notes for the guidance of examiners and for the co-ordination of marking were appointed as follows:

3. Examination centres at 61 locations were arranged by the local examination boards.

4. The examination was held on 25 September 2001.
5. 2511 candidates initially entered for the examination as at the Board's closing date for entries (1 July). However, the final number of candidates entering the examination was 2394, after late entries and withdrawals had both been accepted. 349 (14.6%) absented themselves from the examination. Thus, the number of candidates who attended the examination was 2045.
6. A total of 45 officers attended the marking session together with four assessors, the General Assessor (Scotland) and the Lead Assessor.
7. The marking of scripts took place at Daventry from 28 October to 2 November 2001.

RESULTS

8. Of the 2045 candidates who attempted the whole examination, 602 (29.4%) of those who sat were awarded a pass. *Appendix B (Table II) shows the cumulative results for all candidates entered.*
9. The 2045 candidates attempting the examination included 106 females, of whom 41 were successful in passing the whole examination.
10. The top candidate, Firefighter Adrian Brizzolara, attained 76% in Paper 1, 80% in Paper 2, 93% in Paper 3 and 88% in Paper 4. The candidate attained an 84% mark overall.
11. 349 candidates were absent for all papers of the examination. In addition, 44 candidates were absent from individual papers and under the Restriction of Entry Scheme, 23 candidates (5.9%) appealed to the Board against their automatic barring from next year's examination. Under the delegated authority given to the Chairman all appeals were individually considered and 20 (87%) were upheld.

GENERAL COMMENTS

12. The number of candidates who entered the 2001 examination was 2394, an increase of 31.9%, which more than compensates for the reduction of 9.4% last year, and the number of candidates absenting themselves for all papers was 349 (14.6%) which in numerical terms is an increase of 18 but in percentage terms a reduction of 3.6%. This left 2045 candidates actually attempting the examination, an increase of 561 (37.8%) when compared with last year.
13. Of the 2045 candidates who sat the examination, 602 (29.4%) were awarded a pass, which is an increase on the pass rate of 304 (20.5%) in 2000.
14. As a result of the flexible system for taking the examination, 1245 candidates are indicated as having obtained a pass in at least one of four papers of the examination and are able to progress towards achieving a full pass during the next two years.

15. There was an increase in the number of good quality scripts submitted by candidates, but unfortunately these still remain in the minority. From this it is reasonable to assume that many had not prepared sufficiently or adequately prior to sitting the examination. 273 (11.4%) passed none of the papers attempted which, although an increase in numerical terms, is a reduction in percentage terms when compared to last year's results.
16. Paper 1 – Operations, provided a pass rate of 25.9% which is a reduction on the pass rate of 55.6% last year. The weaker responses were recorded for the questions relating to working with and controlling the application of foam, incident command, and the safety procedures when dealing with a rescue from a confined space.
17. Paper 2 – Fire Safety, Education and Enforcement, provided an improved pass rate of 48.8% to that achieved the previous year (38.8%). There was a general improvement in the quality of answers provided to the questions and this was shown in the pass rate. However, the weaker responses related to how candidates would check and then deal with a false alarm call apparently made by a young person from their home.
18. Paper 3 – Human Resource Management, also provided an improved pass rate of 44.5% when compared to that of last year (32.7%). There was a general improvement in the quality of answers which indicated that many had prepared adequately for the examination by studying the appropriate study notes. The main area of weakness related to knowledge of matters that might be affecting the effectiveness of the crew at an incident, and general knowledge of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act.
19. Paper 4 – Business Administration, dealt with written communication and provided an improved pass rate of 74.8% when compared to 70.9% the previous year. Whereas the overall presentation of answers showed an improvement, the usual grammatical and spelling errors were in evidence.
20. There were no problems with the format of the examination or the instructions to candidates contained in the individual papers.

ASSESSORS AND EXAMINERS' REPORT

21. Detailed comments of the assessors and examiners in connection with the answering of individual questions have been prepared and will be issued to brigades.

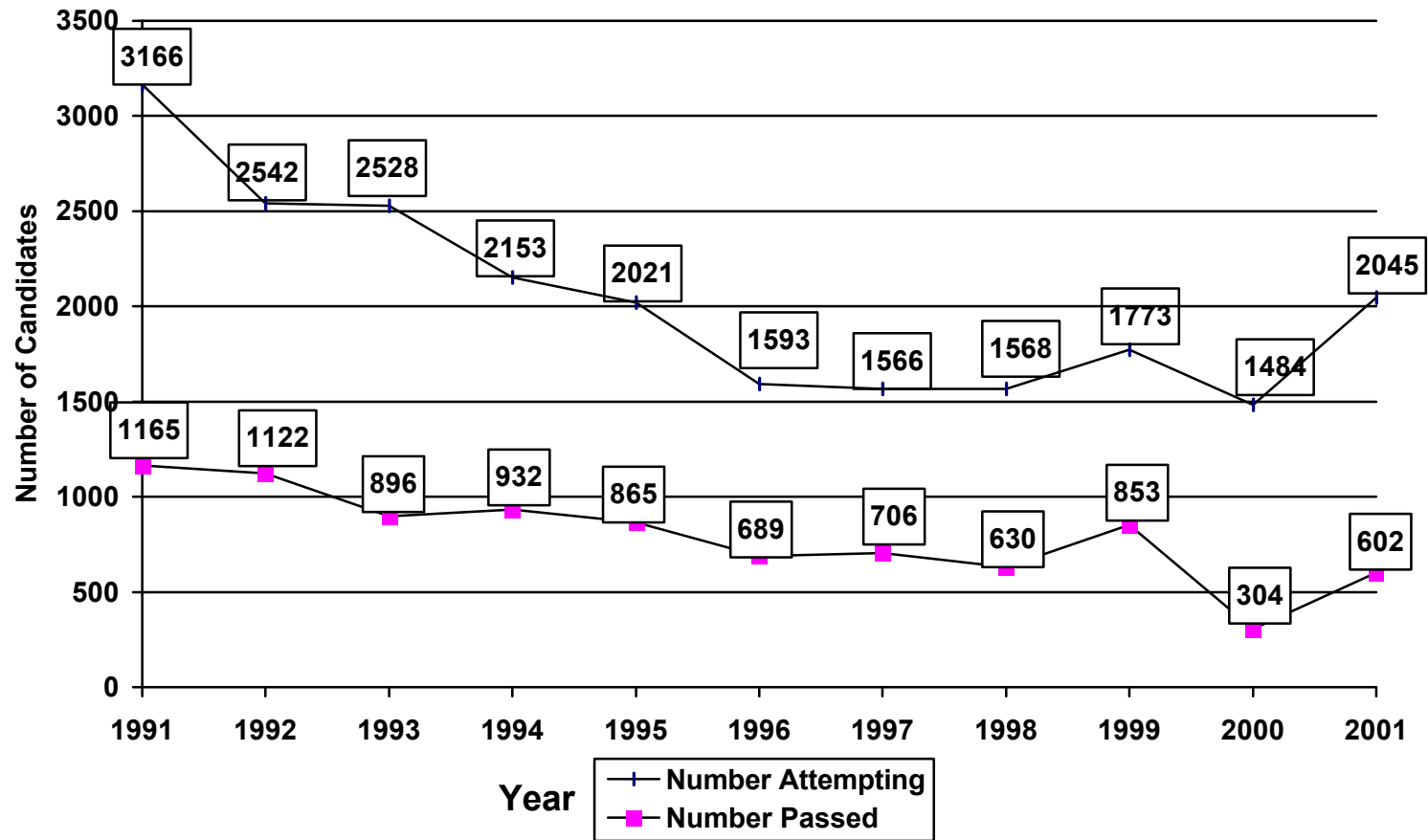
SUMMARY OF RESULTS
