



# Fire Services Examinations Board

REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME DEPARTMENT AND  
THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS ON THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR PROMOTION  
TO THE RANK OF STATION OFFICER 2000

1. The examination was set on the syllabus of study published in May 1997 (2nd Impression February 1998). This was the fourteenth occasion on which the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Station Officer was conducted by the Board.
2. Assessors responsible for the setting of question papers, the preparation of notes for the guidance of examiners and for the co-ordination of marking were appointed as follows:

3. Examination centres at 64 locations were arranged by the local examination boards.
4. The examination was held on Thursday and Friday 24 and 25 February 2000.
5. 1399 candidates initially entered for the examination as at the Board's closing date for entries (1 December). However, the final number of candidates entering the examination was 1279 after late entries and withdrawals had both been accepted. 164(12.82%) absented themselves from the examination. Thus, the number of candidates who attended the examination was 1115. Of these, 435 attempted all four papers.
6. A total of 32 officers attended the marking session together with the Assessors, Assessor Designates, the General Assessor (Scotland), the General Assessor Designate (Scotland) and the Chairman of the Panel of Assessors.
7. The marking of scripts took place at Daventry from 19 – 24 March 2000.

## RESULTS

8. Of the 1115 candidates who attempted the examination, 359(32.2%) were awarded a pass. Appendix B shows the cumulative results for all candidates entered.
9. 16 female candidates entered the examination of whom 7 passed the whole examination.
10. The top candidate, Leading Firefighter Leslie David Britzman, Nottinghamshire Fire & Rescue Service, attained 75% in Paper 1, 84% in Paper 2, 80% in Paper 3 and 94% in Paper 4.
11. 164 candidates were absent from the whole examination and 17 candidates absent from individual papers. With the changes affecting the Restriction of Entry Scheme, under the revised examinations, only candidates whose appeals related to their final year of their three year period were heard. In this respect, 4 candidates appealed to the Board against their automatic barring from next year's examination. Under the delegated authority given to the Chairman all appeals were individually considered and the 4 were upheld. These candidates will have one further year to complete their examination.

## GENERAL COMMENTS

12. The qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Station Officer was the fourteenth to be held under the auspices of the Fire Services Examinations Board covering the whole of the United Kingdom.
13. Of the 1279 initially entered for the examination, 164 (12.8%) absented themselves leaving 1115 actually attempting the examination.
14. Of the 1115 who sat the examination 359 (32.2%) were awarded a pass and are now qualified for promotion to the rank of Station Officer.
15. The flexible system of taking the examination enables candidates to take two, three or four papers in their first attempt. Success in at least one paper enable a candidate to take the remainder of the four over the following two years.
16. From the detail provided it may be noted that within the total of 1115 candidates taking the examination, 435(39.0%) attempted all four papers, 144(12.9%) attempted three, 443(39.7%) attempted two, and 93(8.3%) attempted one.
17. Having previously noted that 359 candidates achieved a pass in all four papers, it will also be noted from the detail provided that of those who attempted the examination, 101 have now achieved passes in three papers, 219 in two, and 226 in one.
18. Following the introduction of the new system, this was the final year for some to pass outstanding papers. Regrettably, 39 failed to do so and their previous passes have now become null and void.
19. The results obtained in the objective questions in papers 1 and 2 indicated that the results achieved by candidates were marginally poorer than those achieved in the previous year.
20. The subjective questions in all four papers provided each candidate with the opportunity to demonstrate the level of knowledge and understanding achieved from their preparation for the examination. When compared to the results achieved last year, improved pass rates were achieved in all papers with the exception of paper 2.
21. The overall standard of the scripts submitted by candidates was generally better than experienced in previous years. There were, of course, the extremes with some scripts being outstanding in their quality, whilst there were others which clearly indicated that those candidates were far from ready for this level of examination, either due to a lack of effective preparation, or an inability to achieve the necessary standards.
22. There were no problems associated with the format of the examination, the venues or the instructions to candidates in the various question papers.

## ASSESSORS' AND EXAMINERS' REPORT

23. Detailed comments of the assessors and examiners in connection with the answering of individual questions have been prepared and will be issued to brigades.

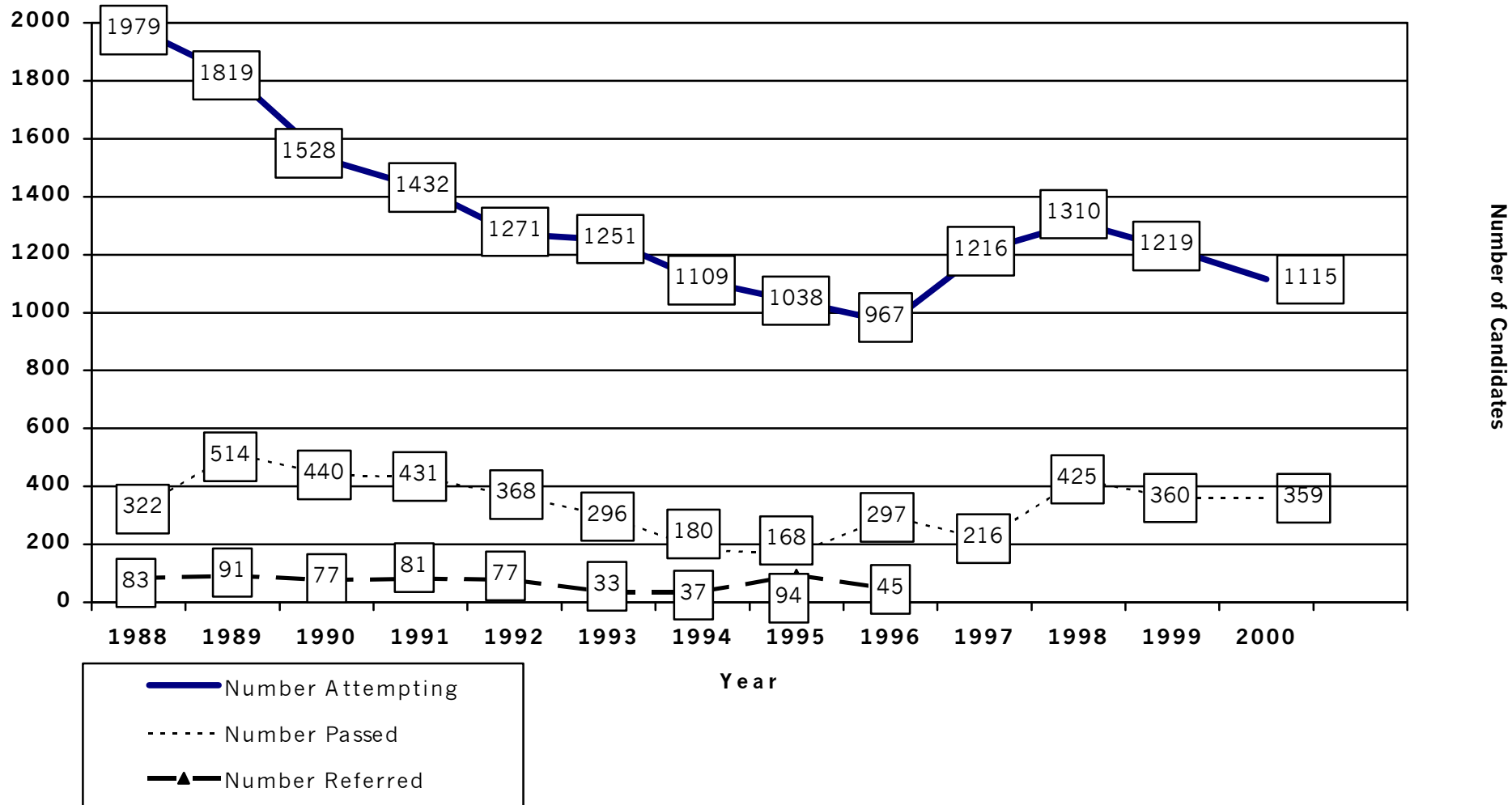
## SUMMARY OF RESULTS
