REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME DEPARTMENT AND
THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS ON THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR PROMOTION
TO THE RANK OF STATION OFFICER 2001

1. The examination was set on the syllabus of study published in May 2000. This was the fifteenth occasion on which the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Station Officer was conducted by the Board.
2. Assessors responsible for the setting of question papers, the preparation of notes for the guidance of examiners and for the co-ordination of marking were appointed as follows:

3. Examination centres at 62 locations were arranged by the local examination boards.
4. The examination was held on Thursday and Friday 22 and 23 February 2001.
5. 1316 candidates initially entered for the examination as at the Board's closing date for entries (1 December). However, the final number of candidates entering the examination was 1217 after late entries and withdrawals had both been accepted. 158(13.0%) absented themselves from the examination. Thus, the number of candidates who attended the examination was 1059. Of these, 360 attempted all four papers.
6. A total of 34 officers attended the marking session together with the Assessors, Assessor Designate, the General Assessor (Scotland), and the Lead Assessor.
7. The marking of scripts took place at Daventry from 18 – 23 March 2001.

RESULTS

8. Of the 1059 candidates who attempted the examination, 274(25.9%) were awarded a pass. Appendix B shows the cumulative results for all candidates entered.
9. 18 female candidates entered the examination of whom 5 passed the whole examination.
10. The top candidate, Leading Firefighter Jonathan Martin Miller, Devon Fire & Rescue Service, attained 71% in Paper 1, 83% in Paper 2, 80% in Paper 3 and 72% in Paper 4.
11. 158 candidates were absent from the whole examination and 37 candidates absent from individual papers. With the changes affecting the Restriction of Entry Scheme, under the revised examinations, only candidates whose appeals related to their final year of their three year period were heard. In this respect, 19 candidates appealed to the Board. Under the delegated authority given to the Chairman all appeals were individually considered and 17 were upheld. These candidates will have one further year to complete their examination.

GENERAL COMMENTS

12. The qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of Station Officer was the fifteenth to be held under the auspices of the Fire Services Examinations Board covering the whole of the United Kingdom.
13. Of the 1217 initially entered for the examination, 158 (13.0%) absented themselves leaving 1059 actually attempting the examination.
14. Of the 1059 who sat the examination 274 (25.9%) were awarded a pass and are now qualified for promotion to the rank of Station Officer.
15. This was the first application of the new examination system which, although still consisting of four papers, now has a new syllabus for each paper, includes a paper on Business Administration (Paper 4), and has only subjective questions all of which needed to be answered by the candidates in each paper. This compares with the former provision of a choice of subjective questions in all papers and the additional use of objective questions in two of the former four papers.
16. The flexibility method of taking the examination, which enable candidates to take two, three or four papers in their first attempt continues. Consequently, only 360 (34.0%) attempted all four papers, 190 (17.9%) attempted three, 412 (38.9%) attempted two, and 97 (9.2%) attempted one.
17. Having previously noted that 274 candidates achieved a pass in all four papers, it will also be noted from the detail provided that of those who attempted the examination, 119 have now achieved passes in three papers, 216 in two, and 259 in one.
18. Because of the flexible system of taking the examination, this was the final year for some candidates to pass outstanding papers. Regrettably, one failed to do so and that candidate's previous passes have now become null and void.
19. It is considered unrealistic to attempt to compare the results obtained in this year's examination to those of previous years because of the differences that have been applied to the examination in general, and each paper in particular. However, the number of candidates attempting the examination reduced by 56 (-5.0%) from the previous year and the number of candidates achieving a pass reduced by 85 (-23.7%).
20. The subjective questions in all four papers provided each candidate with the opportunity to demonstrate the level of knowledge and understanding achieved from their preparation for the examination. The questions were, wherever possible, scenario based and attempted to place the candidate in a situation likely to be met when at work in the rank for which they are being examined.

21. As in previous years, there were extremes in the quality of scripts submitted, some being outstanding in their quality, whereas others suggested that some candidates were ill prepared for this level of examination. However, the vast majority were between these two extremes.
22. There were no problems associated with the format of the examination, the venues or the instructions to candidates in the various question papers.

ASSESSORS AND EXAMINERS' REPORT

23. Detailed comments of the assessors and examiners in connection with the answering of individual questions have been prepared and issued to brigades.

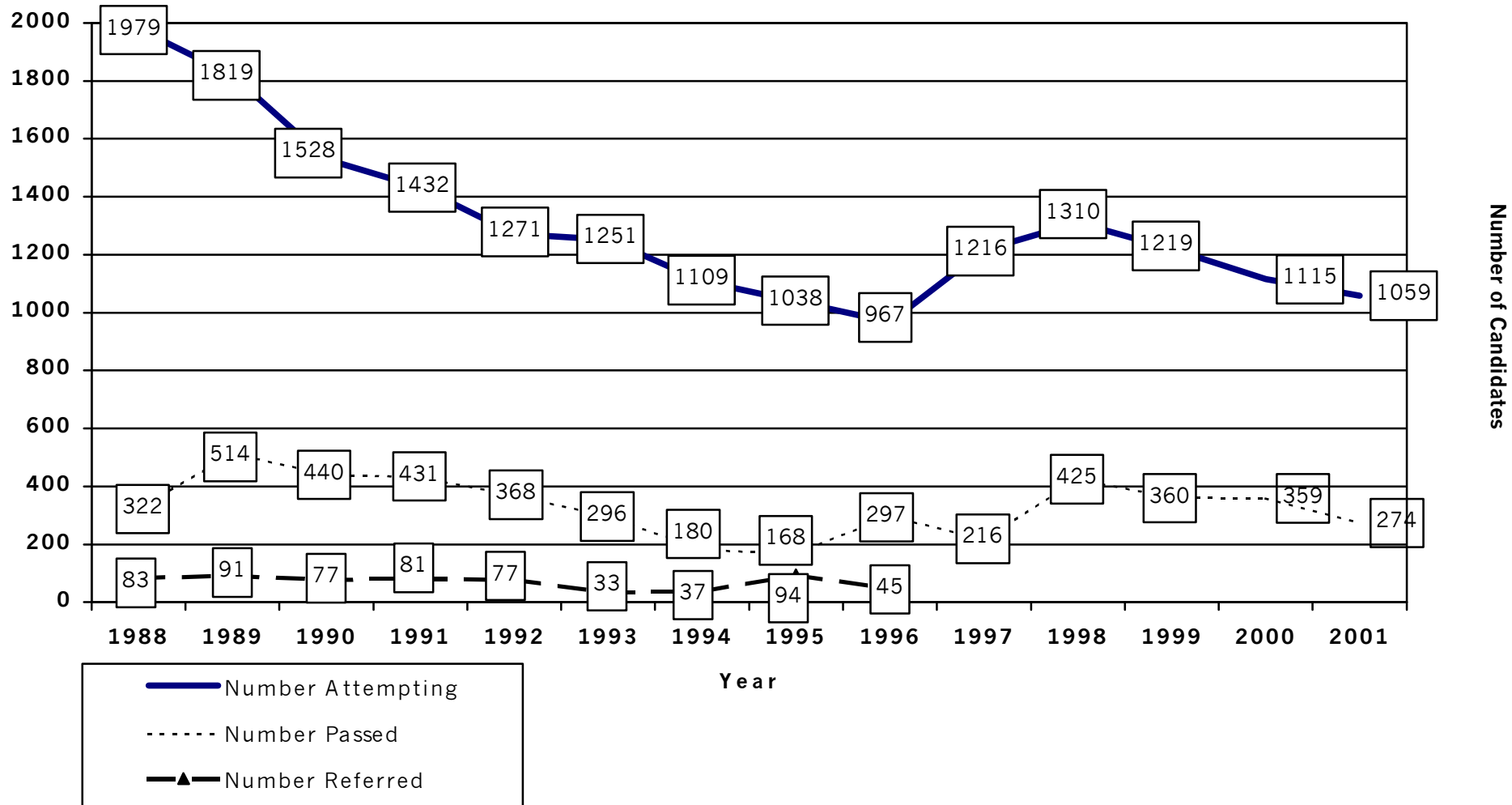
SUMMARY OF RESULTS
