REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME DEPARTMENT AND THE
SCOTTISH MINISTERS ON THE QUALIFYING
EXAMINATION FOR PROMOTION TO THE RANK OF SUB-OFFICER
PART I - WRITTEN EXAMINATION 2000

1. The examination was set on the syllabus of study published in December 1999. This was the fifteenth occasion on which the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of sub-officer was conducted by the Board.
2. The assessors responsible for the setting of question papers, the preparation of notes for the guidance of examiners and for the co-ordination of marking were appointed as follows:

3. Examination centres at 61 locations were arranged by the local examination boards.
4. The examination was held on Thursday 5 October 2000.
5. 1634 candidates initially entered for the examination as at the Board's closing date for entries (1 August). However, the final number of candidates entering the examination was 1581, after late entries and withdrawals had both been accepted. 236 (14.9%) absented themselves from the examination. Thus, the number of candidates who attended the examination was 1345.

6. A total of 40 officers attended the marking session together with the assessors, the General Assessor (Scotland) and the Chairman of the Panel of Assessors.
7. The marking of scripts took place at Daventry from 29 October to 3 November 2000.

RESULTS

8. Of the 1345 candidates, who attempted the examination, 250 (18.6%) of those who sat were awarded a pass in the whole examination. *Appendix B (Table 11) shows the cumulative results for all candidates entered.*
9. The 1345 candidates attempting the examination included 33 females, of whom 6 were successful in passing the whole examination.
10. The top candidate, Firefighter Bryan J Nelson, attained 73% in Paper 1, 70% in Paper 2, 89% in Paper 3 and 96% in Paper 4. The candidate scored 82% overall.
11. 236 candidates were absent for all papers of the examination. In addition, 46 candidates were absent from individual papers and under the Restriction of Entry Scheme, 17 candidates (6.0%) appealed to the Board against their automatic barring from next year's examination. Under the delegated authority given to the Chairman all appeals were individually considered and 12 (70.6%) were upheld.

GENERAL COMMENTS

12. This was the first application of the new examination format using four Papers with all questions to be answered rather than the previous three Papers with a choice of questions.
13. The number of candidates who entered the 2000 examination was 1581, a decrease of 137 and the number of candidates absenting themselves was 236 (14.9%) which in both numerical and percentage terms is a large increase. This left 1345 candidates actually attempting the examination, a decrease of 201 when compared with last year.
14. Of the 1345 candidates who sat the examination, 250 (18.6%) were awarded a pass, which is a decrease on the pass rate of 468 (27.2%) in 1999.
15. As a result of the flexible system for taking the examination, 1027 are indicated as having obtained a pass in at least one of the four papers of the examination and are able to progress towards achieving a full pass during the next two years.
16. It is apparent that some candidates had made a significant effort to prepare themselves for the examination and gave excellent answers to the set questions. Unfortunately these remain in the minority and it was evident that many had not adequately prepared. 134 passed none of the papers attempted, although this is a reduction in numerical and percentage terms when compared to the previous year.

17. It is difficult to compare the passes recorded for the individual papers of the examination due to the changes that have been applied. However, Paper 1 provided a pass rate of 20.7% with weakest responses being recorded for the questions related to incident command structures, the characteristics of a flame, and water relay procedure.
18. Paper 2 – Fire Safety, Education and Enforcement is new to this level of the examination and a pass rate of 44.3% was recorded. The weakest responses related to the questions on automatic venting systems and fire investigation procedures.
19. Paper 3 – Human Resource Management, was another new paper to the examination and the paper's pass rate of 29.8% is disappointing. There was a weakness in all aspects of the subject matter which were examined but this was particularly demonstrated in questions related to performance review, and accident investigation.
20. Paper 4 – Business Administration, related to numerical exercises. The quality of responses provided by candidates was good with some excellent scripts being presented. A pass rate for this Paper of 81.0% reflects the general standard of the scripts submitted.
21. There were no problems with the format of the examination or the instructions to candidates contained in the individual papers.

ASSESSORS AND EXAMINERS' REPORT

22. Detailed comments of the assessors and examiners in connection with the answering of individual questions have been prepared and will be issued to brigades.

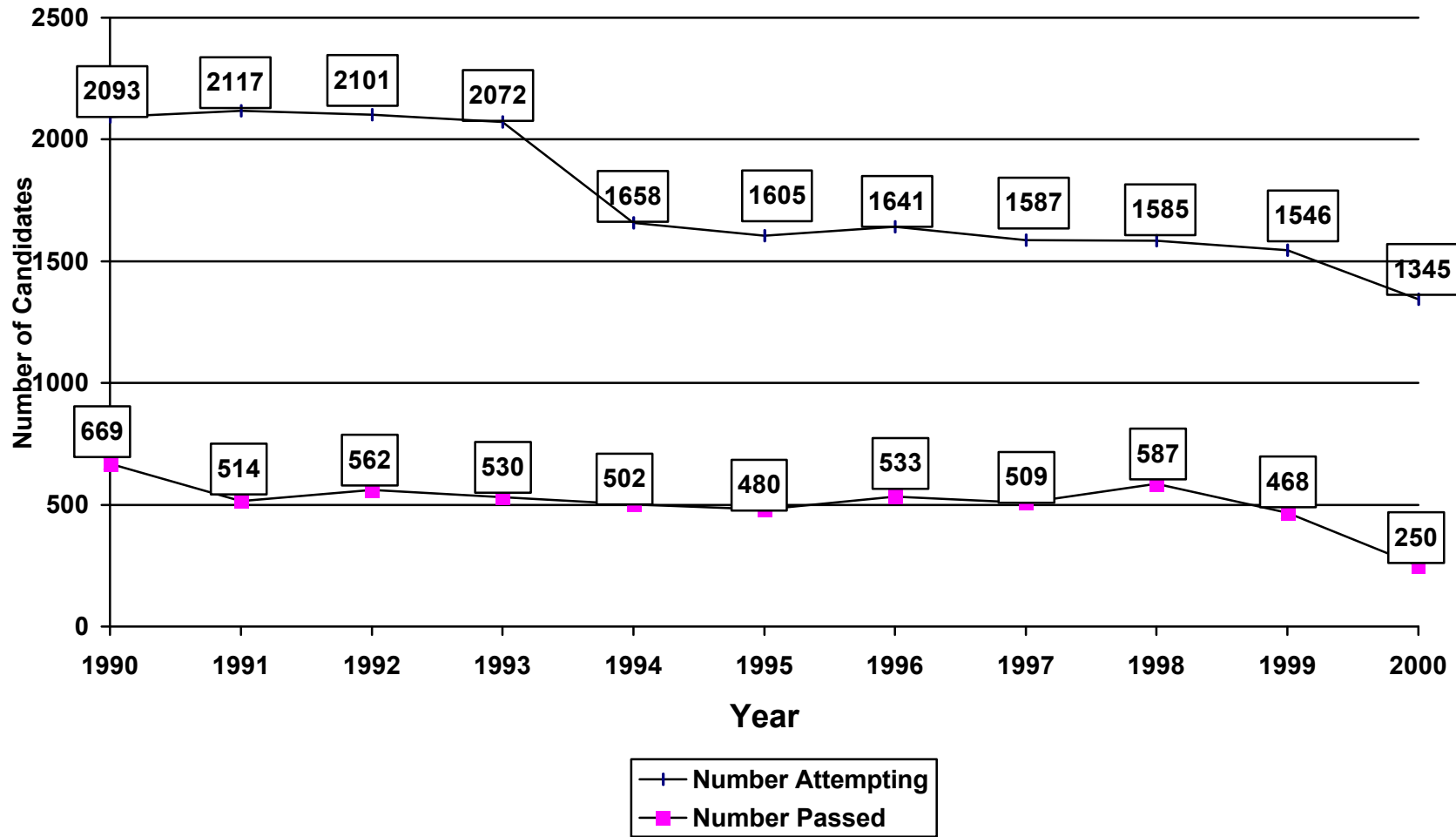
SUMMARY OF RESULTS
